





So that night, Jesus the Son of God wasn't born in a hospital or even a house, He was born in a stable where the animals lived and laid in a manger.














So Joseph took Jesus and Mary that very night and left for the land of Egypt.

When they reached Bethlehem, Joseph tried to find a place for them to stay at the Inns but the city was full and there was no room for them at the Inn.




So that night, Jesus the Son of God wasn't born in a hospital or even a house, He was born in a stable where the animals lived and laid in a manger.


