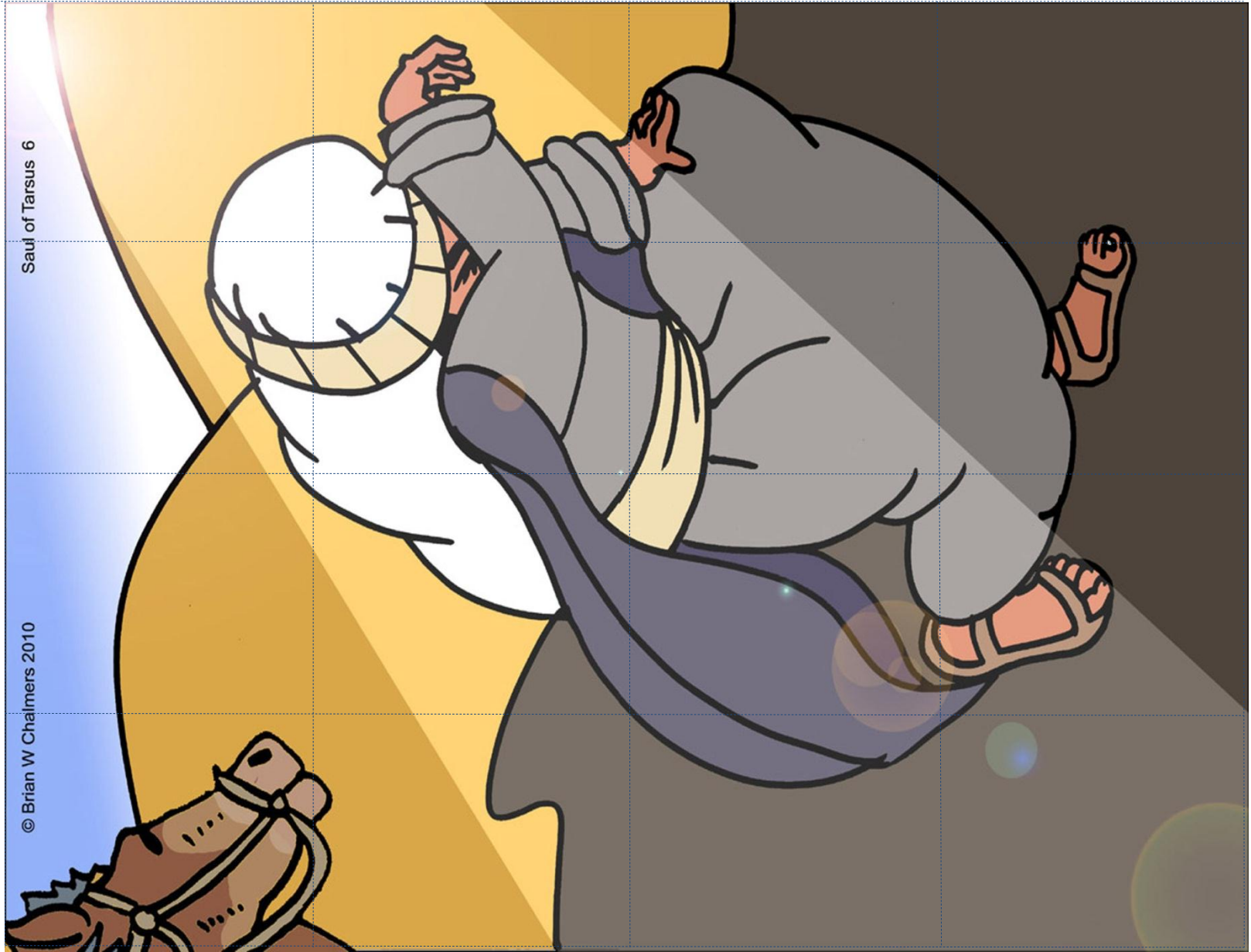

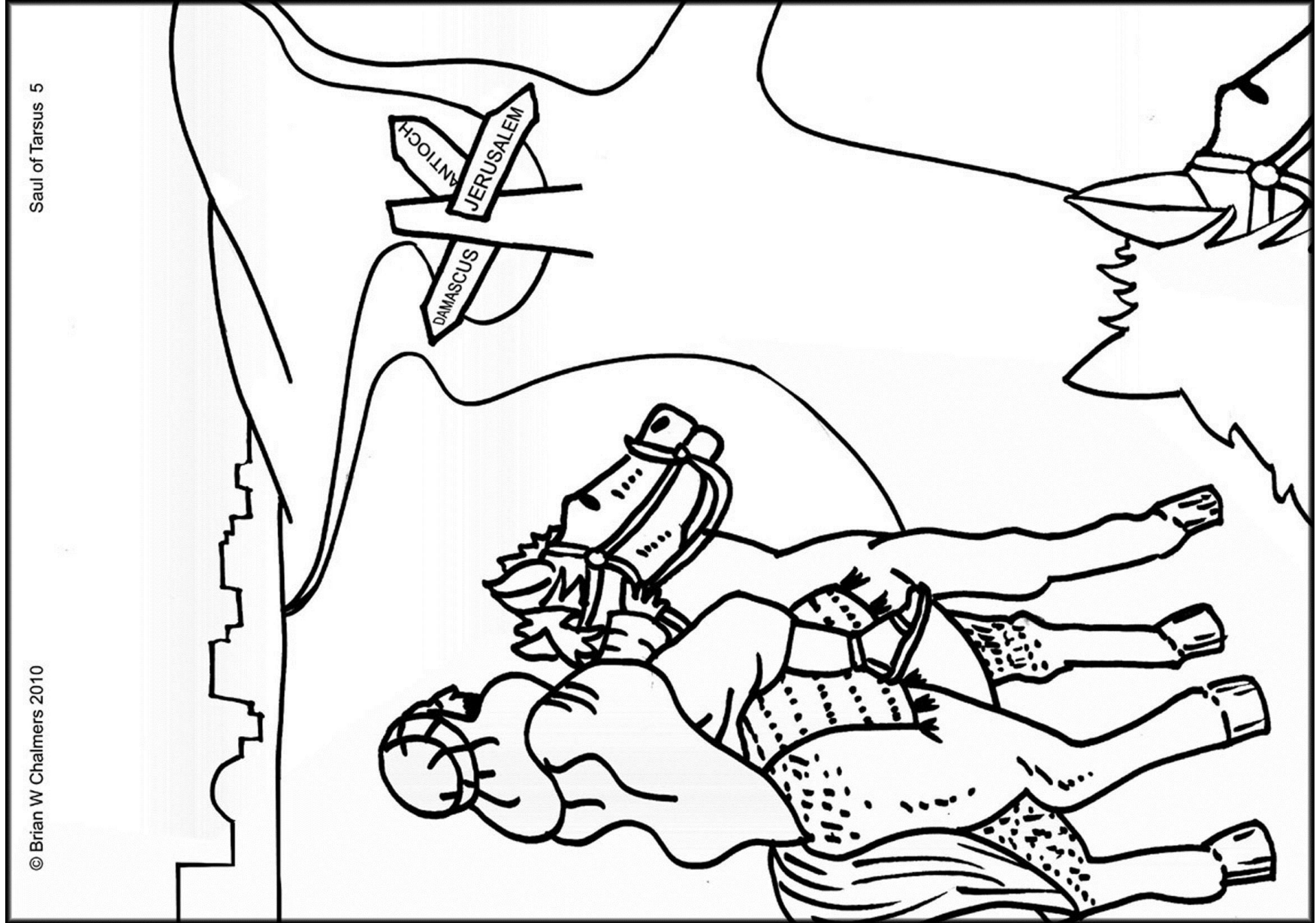

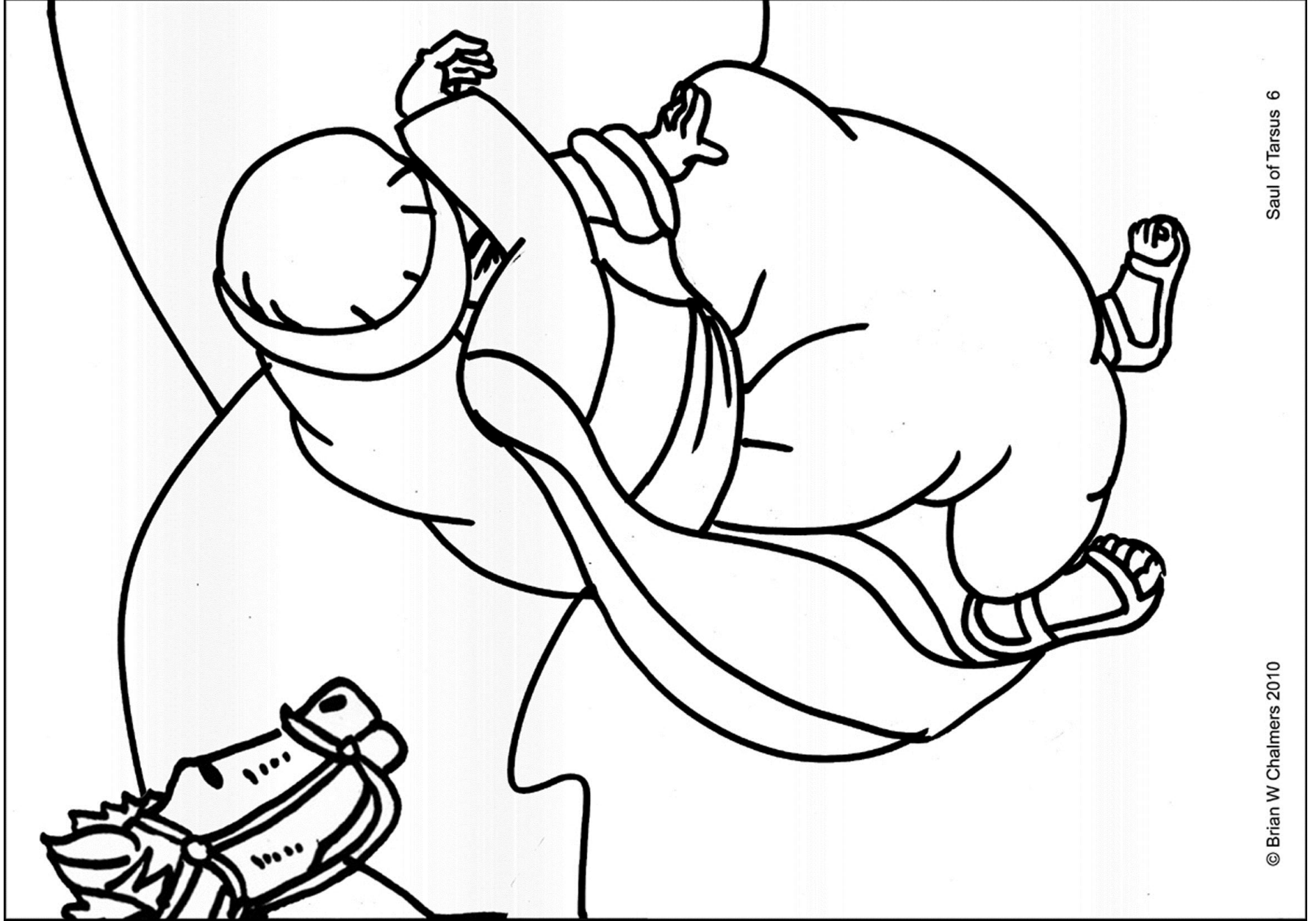


Saul of Tarsus 5
