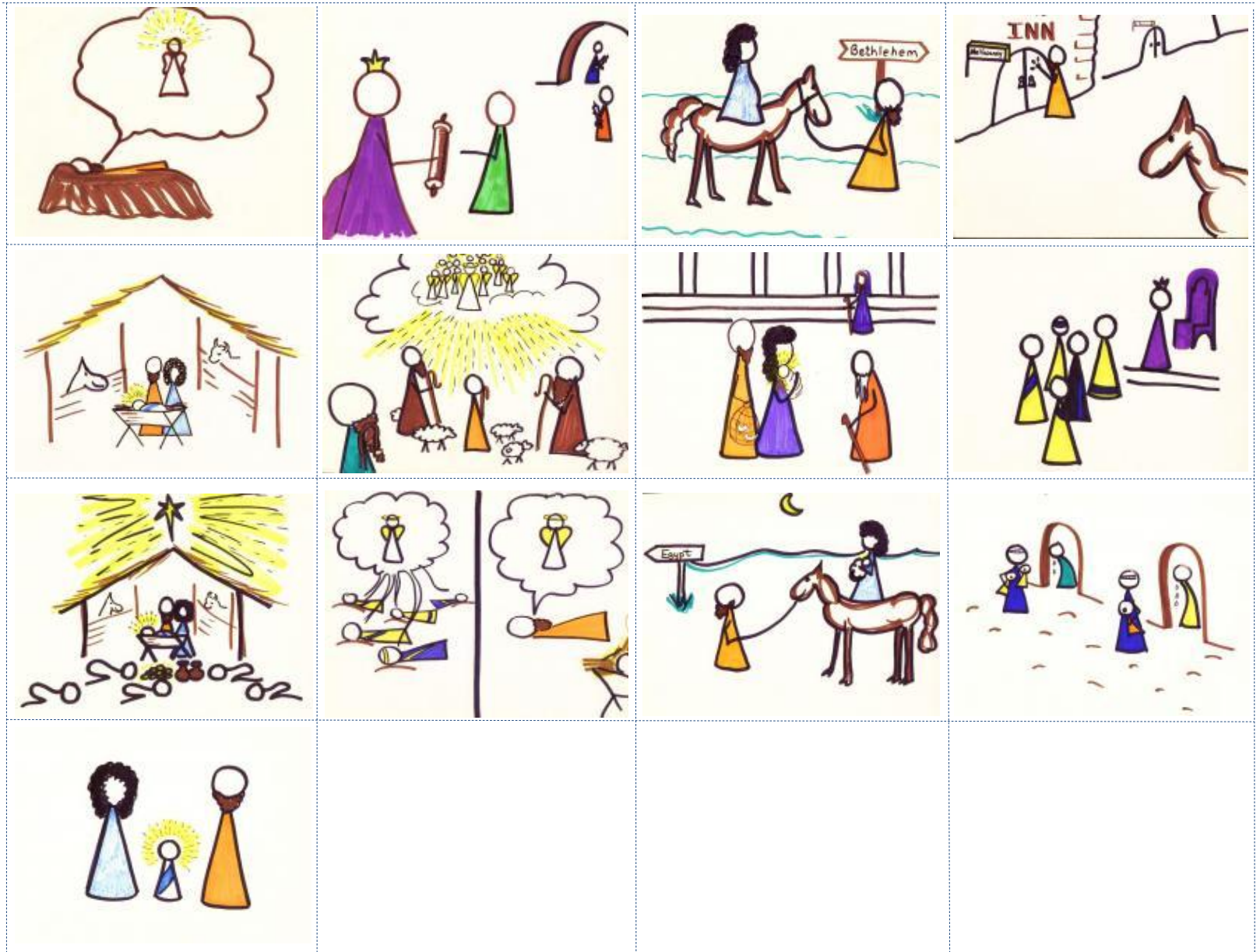

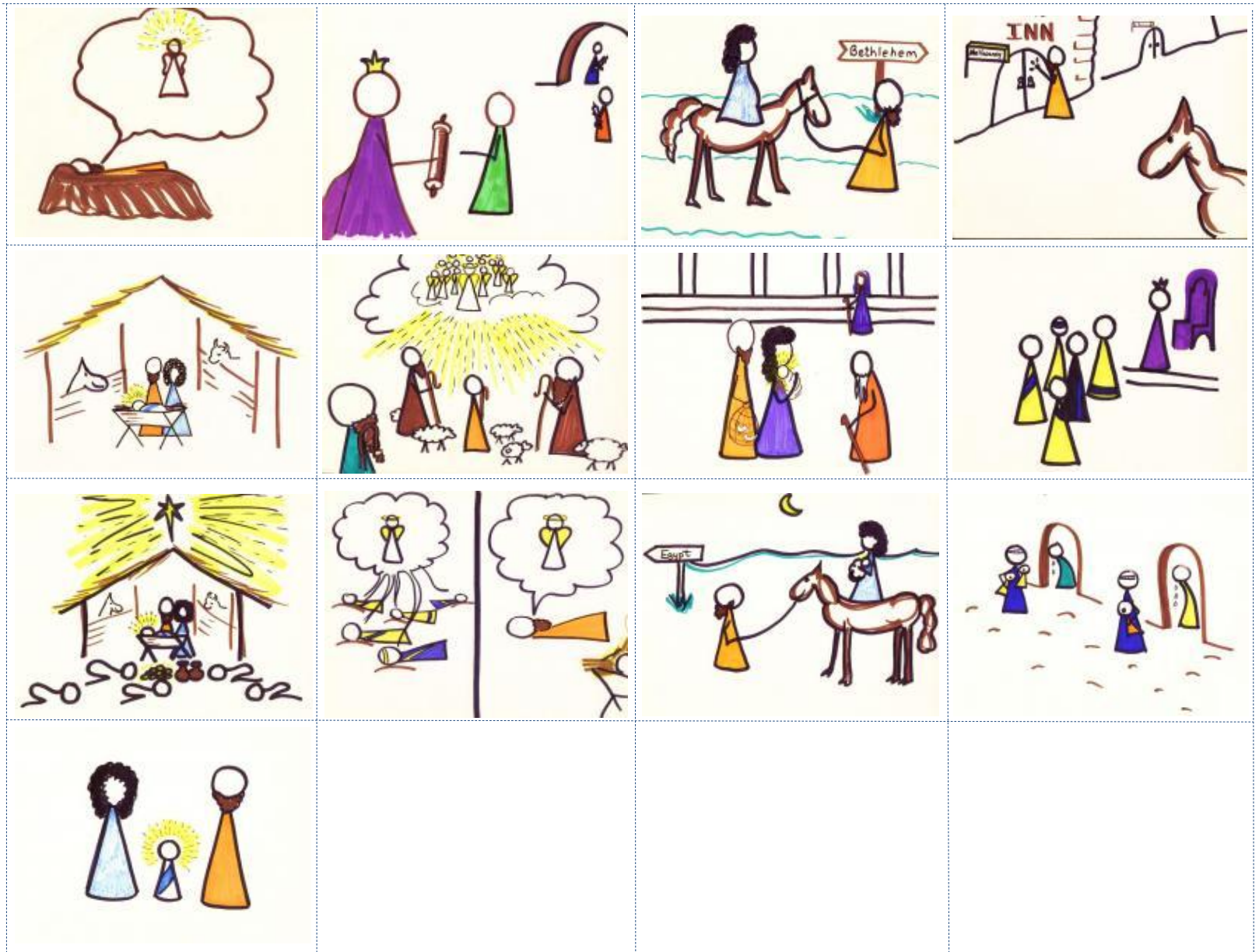

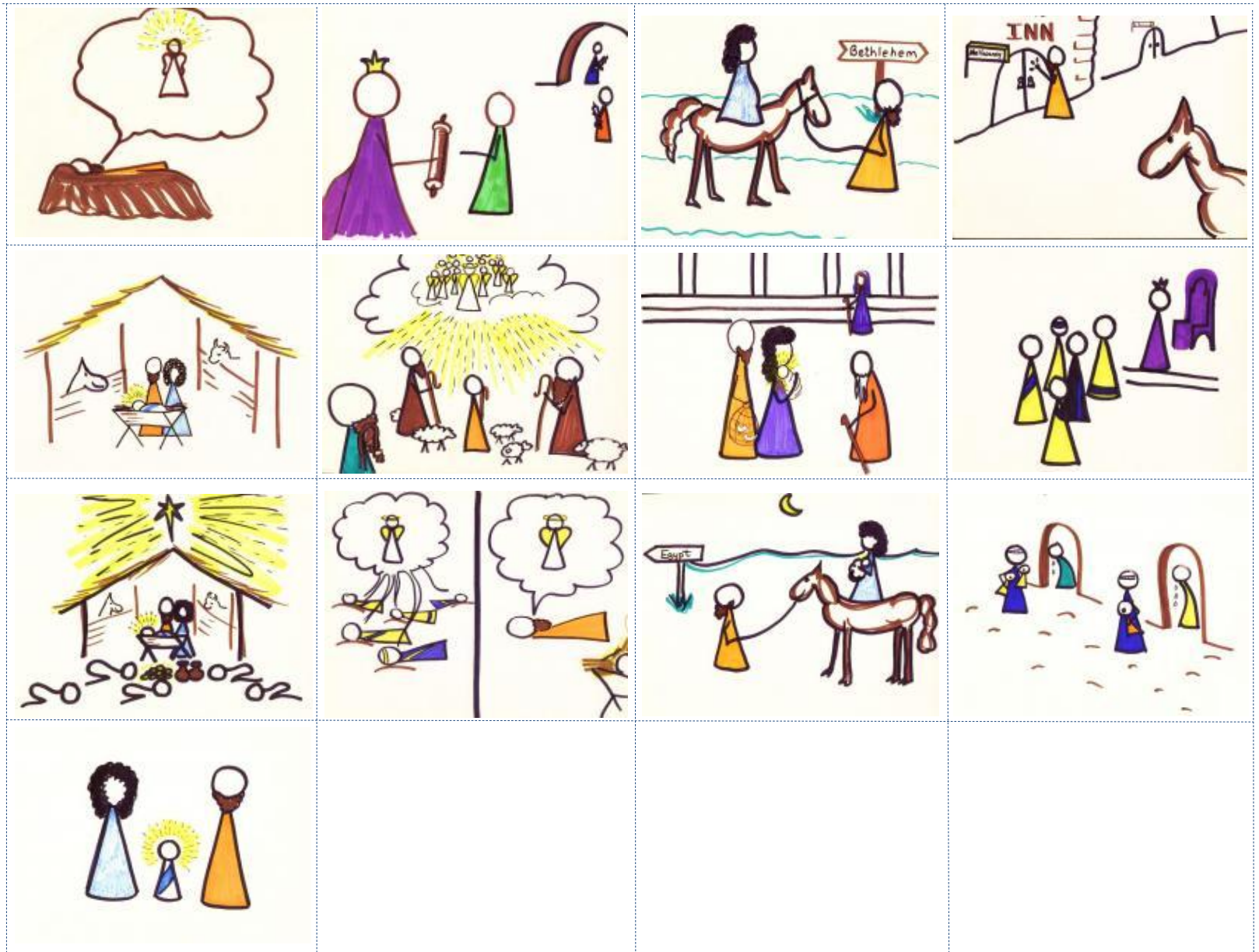
Cut out and give your students the mini images and have them put the images in order and retell the story to the class. For best results, print on card stock.

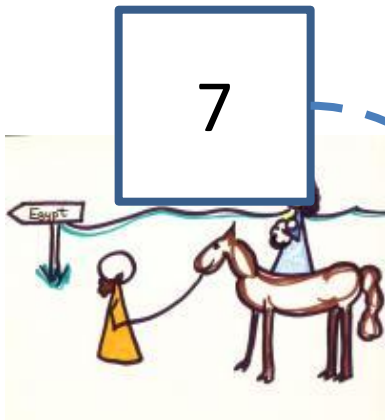
