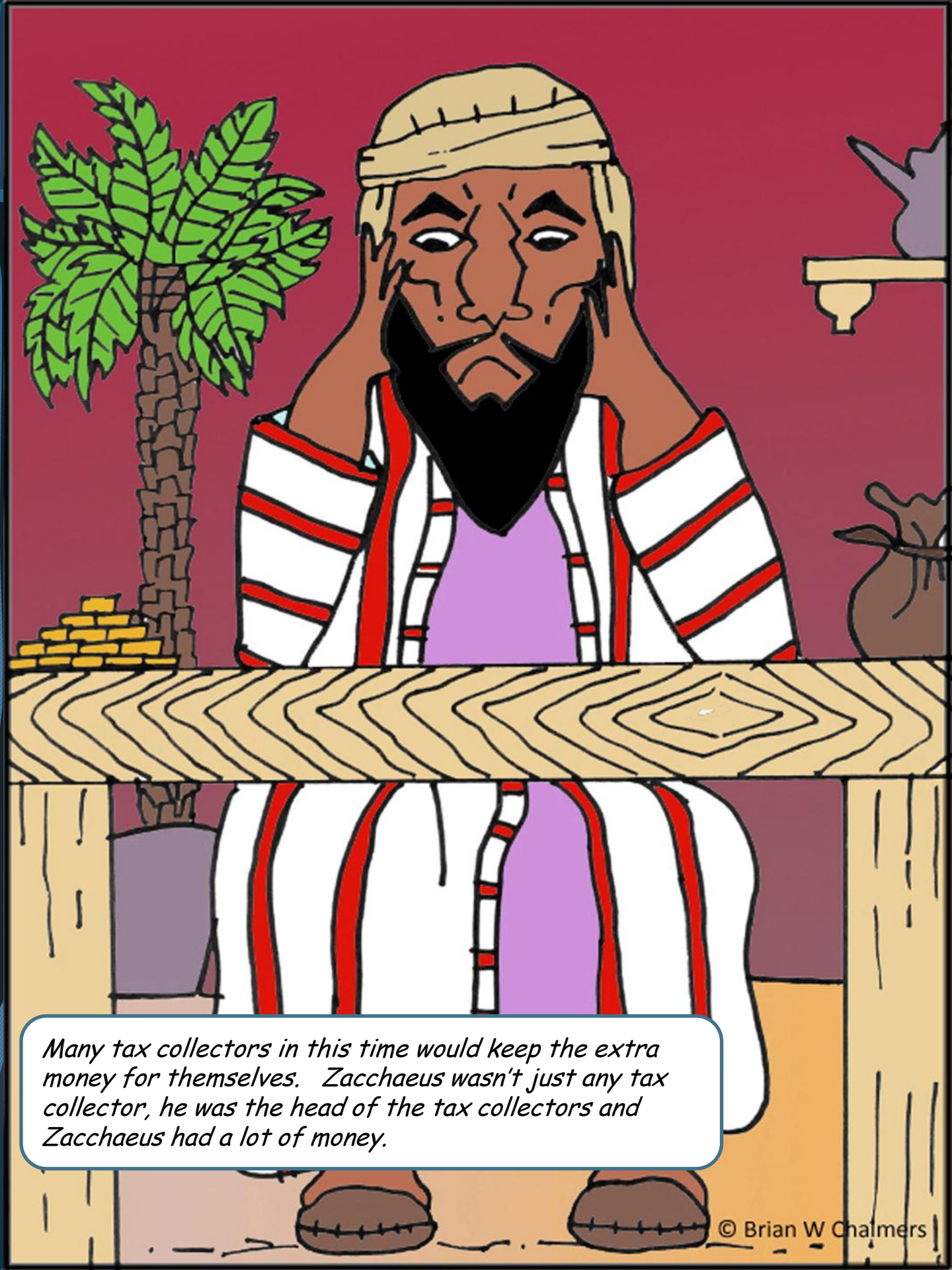
*In the city of Jericho there lived a man who was a tax collector. His name was Zacchaeus.*





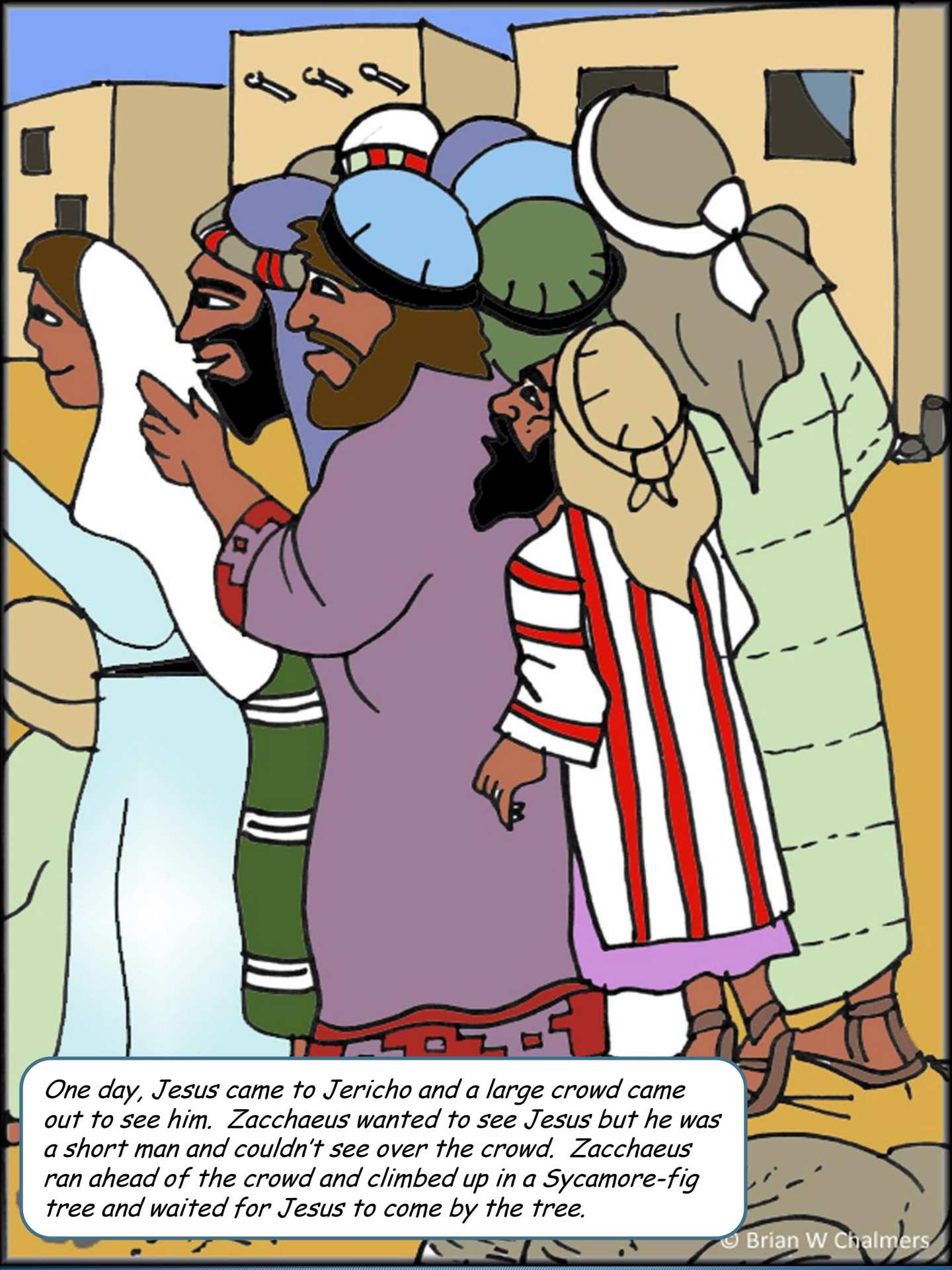


*The people didn't like tax collectors. Many tax collectors cheated the people and they often got more taxes than they were supposed to get.*

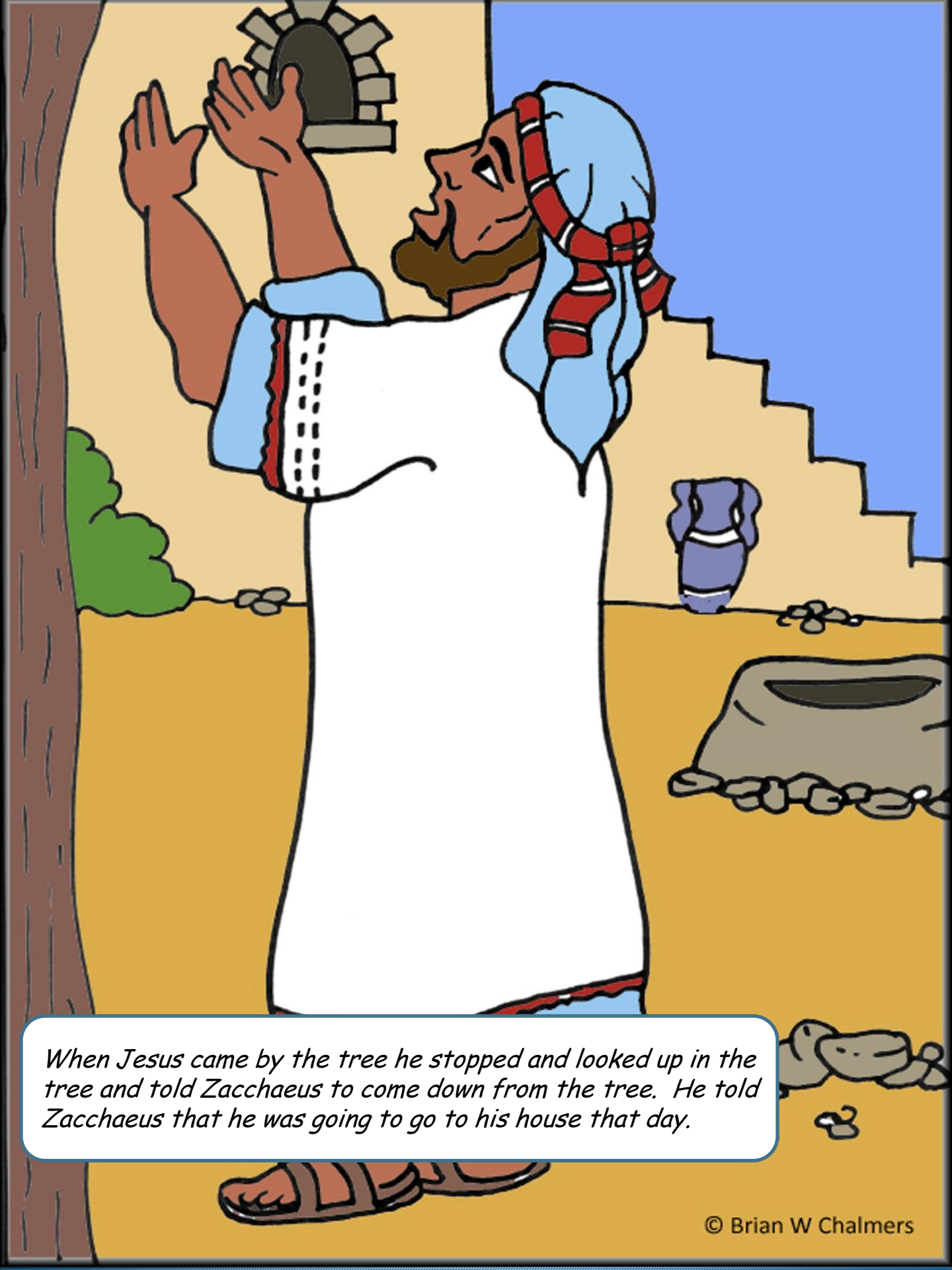

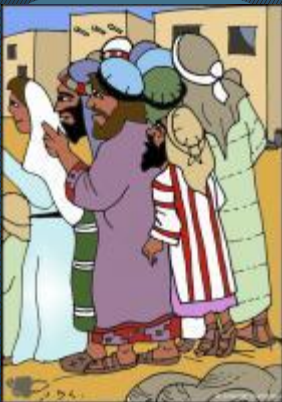
